Notes from the meeting:

Present: Yr 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6.

- Last meeting actions:
- Ceiling tiles still need replacing
- Small football goals no longer needed
- AD has obtained quotes for extending the trim trail and fitness machines
- All weather running track too expensive at the moment (£20k)

Issues from classes:

- Year 6 – Charity fundraiser for all classes to access on 2nd July. SE to write a paragraph explaining the event for this week's newsletter. Picnic benches to be refurbished over summer holidays. Some children keep getting hit by footballs on the playground. Tuesday and Thursdays to be football free days.
- Year 5 – barrier for the quiet garden – RH explained that this was removed to enable the trees to grow to form a natural barrier. Cleanliness of toilets and keep getting blocked. RH to speak to AD. Gymnastics area with mats on the field – VC explained that it needs to be supervised by a teacher which can't happen at lunch as they are on a break.
- Year 4 – Quiet garden entrance needs trimming. RH to speak to LC. Holes in big hut to be filled – RH explained this is on the summer works job list. More equipment for playtime. ML to choose items from the catalogue. Digital leaders to be introduced – RH said Sep. More forest school lessons for years 1-6 (not 4), RH will speak to MM about the possibility of this.

- Year 2 – Larger cups for dining hall on hot days. VC agreed cups just need to be filled more frequently.
- Year 1 – More equipment to use for playtime.
