<p>Play and Explore</p> <p>A session for families and Carers with children aged 0 to 5 years . Children can explore and learn whilst playing with a range of activities</p> <p>0 to 5 years. Older children are welcome</p>	<p>Child Health Drop-ins</p> <p>Run by the health visiting service in a variety of venues. They provide an opportunity for you to turn up and talk to staff and other parents. You can discuss and review your child's growth and development as well as gathering information on health promotion topics to support you in your parenting journey</p>	<p>Getting To know your Baby (new born)</p> <p>4 weekly sessions covering topics such as sleep, feeding, weaning, minor ailments, safety and development. The group is a great opportunity to share experiences, ask questions and make new friends</p>
<p>Development Reviews</p> <p>Appointment only with your Health Visitor</p> <p>1 and 2 years development reviews carried out by your health team. This will look at your child's development and health and ensure any issues are noticed early</p>	<p>Song Time</p> <p>A chance for you and your child to listen to stories and sing some songs. No need to book . Don't forget your library card as the library will be open.</p> <p>0 to 5 years</p>	<p>Little Talkers</p> <p>You must have been through the Screening Clinic in order to be booked onto the Little Talkers group. Please contact Speech and Language therapists on: 01296 566045.
