

A good place to drop a group off is at the Old Town Car Park. There are toilets here.

# Amersham Old Town Maths Trail



**1. Misbourne River** - In the back (N) corner of the car park follow the River Walk trail along the edge of the Misbourne until you come to the second small pedestrian bridge. Do take care along here even though the river is shallow.



**2. St Mary's Church** - St Mary's Church is on your left as you carry along the river. The former brewery is on your right, an important industry for Amersham in the 1800's and earlier



**3. Memorial Garden** - Leave the Church by the South entrance towards the High Street. Enter the memorial garden on your left hand side. There is a drinking bottle fill up station in here.



**4. Market Hall** - Exit the memorial garden and turn right along the High Street. The Market Hall stands in the road 50m along the High Street.



**5. Amersham Museum** - Further along the High Street on the right you will find the Amersham Museum. You could extend your day by booking a slot for the group here.



**6. Methodist Chapel** - Carry along the High Street. On the right, opposite The Swan you will see the Methodist Chapel.



**7. Drakes Almshouses** - Cross the road carefully and head back passing The Swan. You will see the Drakes Almshouses on your right behind a gate. The Drake Family controlled much of Old Amersham from the 1600's to 1800's.



**8. Old Grammar School** - Follow the High Street back passing the Market Hall. Cross over near the Memorial Garden and look out for the Old Grammar School along from here.
