

Chesham Maths Trail

A good place to drop a group off is at the Star Yard Car Park. There are some toilets here if needed.

1. The Broadway - Head down Blucher St towards town. On your right you will see the Broadway Baptist Church. At the end of Broadway you will find a WWI statue of a soldier.



2. High Street - Take a right down High Street following signs for Town Council. Half way along you will see an arch for the Chesham Town Council building. Walk down here to find the Heritage Interpretation Board.



3. Clock Tower - Retrace your steps back to the High Street. Turn right and walk up to the Clock Tower. Take a look at the Stirling Bell plaque and the clock that is marked out in Roman Numerals.



4. Church Street - Take a right along Church St. just before the clock tower. On your right you will see and oddly shaped house of many angles.



5. Temperance Hall - Church St crosses the dual carriageway. There is a Zebra Crossing around to the left. Cross here and then re-join Church Street until you see the Temperance Hall on your right.



6. Bury Lane - Turn right up Bury Lane. The houses along here would be a good spot to look at brick bonds. Further along on your right, you will see a plaque on the wall for the Sixpenny Houses.



7. Church - Bury Lane continues into Lowndes Park. Turn left here and head up towards St Mary's Church. Then retrace your steps back to Lowndes Park but watch out for the shallow lake.



8. Lowndes Park - Follow the main path across the park to the Performance Circle Area on your right. Also look out for the Interpretation Boards near here. There are more toilets at the end of the park. Cross back over the dual carriageway to Star Yard Parking.
