1. Broadway - Just outside the church you will see a bus stop. Work out how much times passes between the first and last bus to travel on a Saturday.

2. Town Hall - How many years ago was the painting on the interpretation board of Old Chesham produced? Can you recognise any of the buildings still around today? How long is the Town Hall open for each day?

3. Clock Tower - Beneath your feet in this area are some interesting tessellation brick patterns. Try to draw a small section from each different section. There are at least 4 different types.

4. Angular House - Can you see any 2D or 3D shapes in the area near the angular house?

5. Temperance Hall - Stay on Church Lane, pass Bury Lane on your right, the path becomes narrower so be careful here. You will see Chesham's oldest house on the left Number 54 and 56. It is said to date from the 14th Century. How old is this house to the nearest 100 years?

6. Bury Lane - There are many more angles and shapes along Bury Lane. See if you can draw, record or measure some.

7. The Church - What time do the church services run on Sunday at St Mary's Church

8. Lowndes Park - Find the conglomerate stone over near the play area. It might look like a bit of old concrete but this rock formation was made millions of years ago, bonding rounded rock fragments in sediment. Estimate how many smaller stones are embedded in the conglomerate?
