- wipe & blow nose



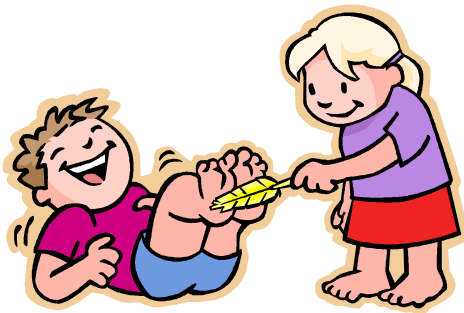
3 Communication, Language & Literacy

- can walk up/down stairs

- uses pencils or crayons to make marks on paper
- can hold scissors and snip
- uses left/ right /or both hands

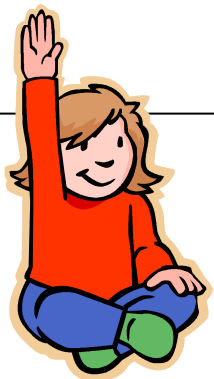


6 Knowledge & Understanding of the World
