Dear Parents / Carers,

Welcome back to the start of this new school year, I hope you have enjoyed a relaxing summer break. I'm very excited to have the pleasure of teaching your children all in what's promised to be another fantastic year!

Staffing

I am joined by Mrs Bradshaw, our learning support assistant, who will be supporting the class. Mrs Cook will be teaching the class on Tuesday (10:30 am onwards).

PE

PE this term will be on a Tuesday and Friday. Children are expected to come to school prepared for PE lessons in their full PE kit. If the weather is severe, the session will be postponed or moved into the hall. However, all children are expected to come to school prepared for outdoor sessions in warm and cold weather. Alongside the school PE kit, pupils may wear plain house-coloured jumpers and tracksuit bottoms. Please ensure an alternative pair of shoes are provided, should their PE trainers get muddy. PE will commence on Friday 5th September.

Homework

As you are aware pupils homework is set primarily on the platform Century. Children will be set 4 assignments (known as nuggets) to complete each week. These will relate to lesson content from their learning that week and cover maths, comprehension, SPAG and times tables. Every Friday on google classroom, the spelling list will be posted along with details of a mini tournament on TTRS. Please ensure your child practices their spellings and Multiplication. Spelling tests will be on a Tuesday.

Equipment

All children are expected to bring their own equipment to school. In Year 4, a pencil case should contain: 2 blue writing pens (no biro), 2 pencils, a whiteboard pen, a ruler, a rubber, scissors, glue stick and colouring pencils. Be sure to use a small pencil case: it must fit into a drawer.

Trips

On Thursday 2nd October pupils have an exciting trip to Amaravati Buddhist Monastery as part of their learning of Buddhism in RE. You will receive a letter soon going into more detail about the trip.
