It is with great excitement that I write to you, welcoming you back to a new academic year at school. As your child's final year at primary school, Year 6 requires a lot of hard work and effort to meet the range of challenges ahead. However, it is also a year full of new opportunities and fun-filled activities, all of which I am sure the class will rise to.

The Year 6 teaching team includes Miss Higgs, supported by Mrs Davies; Mrs Cook will cover non-contact time.

Equipment

All children are expected to bring their own equipment to school. In Year 6, a pencil case should contain:

- 2 pens (with spares recommended)
- 2 pencils
- A ruler
- A rubber
- Scissors

- Colouring pencils
- A black fine-liner
- Colouring pens (optional)

Guided Reading

This term, the children will be reading *Holes* by **Louis Sachar**, which will be provided by the school.

Homework

All tasks will be set via Century. Children will be set 4 assignments (known as nuggets) to complete each week. These will relate to lesson content from their learning that week and will cover maths, comprehension, SPAG and times tables. Once children have completed their weekly tasks, they will then be able to interact with other material relevant to them on their learning path, starting with diagnostic tests. Once children have completed diagnostic tests, they will then be provided with individual tasks to support their learning. In addition, weekly spellings will be set via Google
