Dear Parent/Carer,

It is with great excitement that I write to you, welcoming you back to a new term at school. I hope you had a restful break and are ready for the term ahead. Below, you will find details for this term.

The Year 6 teaching team includes Miss Higgs, supported by Mrs Davies; Mrs Cook will cover non-contact time on a Tuesday afternoon.

Equipment

All children are expected to bring their own equipment to school. In Year 6, a pencil case should contain:

- 2 pens (with spares recommended)
- 2 pencils
- A ruler
- A rubber
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Colouring pencils
- A black fine-liner
- Colouring pens (optional)

Please use a **small pencil case**, as large ones will not fit in trays.

Guided Reading

This term, the children will be reading *Cogheart* by **Peter Bunzl**, which will be provided by the school.

Homework

All tasks will be set via Century. Children will be set 4 assignments (known as nuggets) to complete each week. These will relate to lesson content from their learning that week and will cover maths, comprehension, SPAG and times tables. Once children have completed their weekly tasks, they will then be able to interact with other material relevant to them on their learning path. In addition, weekly spellings will be set via Google Classroom. Homework will be set every Friday and will be due the following Friday. A spelling test will also take place each Friday. As last term, all pupils are encouraged to engage daily with Sparx Reader to support the development of reading fluency and comprehension.

PE

For this half term only, PE lessons will take place on **Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons** and may be indoors or outdoors. In severe weather, PE may move to the hall or be postponed. Children must be prepared for **both warm and cold outdoor sessions**. Alongside the school PE kit, pupils may wear **black tracksuit bottoms and a grey sweatshirt**.
