



'Wow!' Stars

In Nursery we use 'WOW' stars to help us gain an understanding of your child's achievements beyond the 'school gate' and to be able to celebrate these achievements with your child and their peers. Additionally, we feel they are a really positive way to celebrate the home/school relationship for your child!

The completion of 'WOW' stars can be undertaken by parents/carers or any adult who has been given responsibility for your child outside of school hours - for example: grandparents and other close relatives, child-minders etc. We also welcome photographs, pictures and/or writing to support the content of the 'WOW' stars.

Once your child has shared their 'Wow' moment with the class, they are placed in your child's 'Learning Journey'. The information we gather from them is a valuable source of evidence when completing your child's personal profile data.

Below are some examples of possible 'WOW' star comments:

- 'Alex helped his granny with the washing up because he thought she was very busy'
- 'Lucy told us her favourite book was 'The Gruffalo'. She then told us the whole story all by herself.'
- 'Anneena said she was always going to clean her teeth after breakfast and before she went to bed because she wanted to look after them properly.'
- 'Suzie helped mummy peg all the socks on the line. She then counted how many altogether.'
- 'Akhil was painting a picture of his favourite dinosaur. He told me that when he mixed his blue and yellow together, bits of his dinosaur went green.'

Every child will receive some 'WOW' Star sheets at the start of the year. When you need more they are always available in the classroom, or just send a message and we will put some new sheets in your child's book bag.
